We make them this promise whenever they arrive at Grace House...

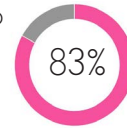

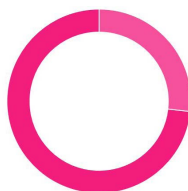
Since 1992, Grace House has provided stable, Christian homes to Alabama girls in foster care on our residential campus in Fairfield, AL. We aim to break the generational cycles of poverty and abuse by providing our girls with family care, a Christ-centered environment, a quality education, and services that extend beyond high school.

In 2017,

**61** girls ages 6-21 called Grace House home...



including **10** sibling groups.

(plus an additional **11** girls ages 18-24 lived off-campus.)

They came from **15** different counties...and stayed for an average of **5** months.



**43** girls attended the Grace House Campus School, and **2/3** of them made A/B honor each semester.

**5** girls graduated high school, and



**13** were enrolled in college.
